



Tidy Up Your Wiring

Stick a piece of Velcro to a suitable place in your hull, then neatly arrange your wiring on it and trap the wires with the mating Velcro piece. Wire connections are then held firmly in place and are less likely to become damaged.

Velcro with double sided sticky tape is available for easy fixing to the hull, and this method can also be used to hold small items of equipment such as receivers and battery packs.
