

Radio Frequencies

Enclosed with this newsletter you will find the up to date list of radio frequencies which club members are using. Please take a moment to study it and inform Brian King if there are any errors or changes which need making.

You are reminded that club rules do not permit the use of a radio transmitter without a protective ping-pong ball or similar item on the end of your transmitter aerial, which will prevent inadvertent injury being caused to somebody. If you do not use one, you may be politely asked to stop sailing until you can fit one.

The club operates a frequency board at all major events and you are also reminded that you should not turn on your radio gear until you have obtained a peg or confirmed that your frequency is available with all members who are sailing.

Forthcoming Events

You will find a list of fixtures for this season enclosed with this newsletter. It generally follows the pattern of previous years, however we have included a number of new events.

Firstly, we are going to try and re-introduce some vintage yacht racing at Ramsey Mooragh. These two events effectively replace the Tynwald day and August Bank Holiday events which we held at Port St. Mary during past years. They are open to all free sailing models of any age, so have a look in your attic and dust off those 'old timers'. The event will probably be informal this year, deciding on classes, a course and race duration depending on the number of entrants and wind conditions. The events start in the evening when the lake at Ramsey should be a little quieter.

Although Thursday evenings have traditionally been club nights, we are extending the invitation to sail to virtually any evening during the summer season when the weather is suitable. Remember that Onchan Park does not officially close until 9:00pm during the summer, so please observe this time to avoid upsetting the commissioners. If you are going for a sail, have a ring around to invite one or two more members to make a up a party.

We have included one or two UK events in the fixture list. The Club does not officially attend the Windermere steam boat rally, but a couple of members made up a small party last year to attend. Please let us know if you are thinking of attending this year.

The club does officially attend the Ellesmere Port show in August. If you are thinking of attending, you need to sort out your travel and accommodation arrangements now. The Steam Packet sailings and prices are not very convenient this year due to the cancellation of last years Grand Prix, and the Holiday Inn hotel at the venue will not be available due to a fire. Most members are now booking rooms in the Burleigh Dam, just up the road, but rooms are filling up fast for the weekend. Please ask one of the committee if you want further help or information on this one!

The main highlights from the start of the season are listed below, but keep reading your newsletters for updates and changes as the season progresses.

<u>Easter Egg Yacht Race - Sunday 31st March - Ramsey Mooragh - 6:30pm.</u>

This race is for 1m radio controlled yachts around the lake at Ramsey Mooragh. The winners prize is a chocolate Easter Egg. This years event is on Easter Sunday evening, turn up in plenty of time to get your boat ready before the start.

Scale Steering Competition - Sunday 7th April - Onchan Park - 2:30pm

This event is for under 1 meter and over 1 meter scale boats. You have to navigate your boat around a course which is laid out on the lake using Port & Starboard marker buoys as well as a number of other obstacles such as icebergs and narrow channels. Points are lost for each touch or missed gate, with the winner in each class being the competitor with the lowest score at the end of two runs.

Scale & "On the Water" Competitions - Sunday 5th May - Silverdale - 10:00am

Unfortunately this event was poorly attended last year, so we could do with making up for it and putting on a better show this year. There should be plenty of new boats available for the competition, however even if you don't think that you boat is good enough, please turn up and put it on display to make up the numbers. There are classes for scratch built, kit built and semi-scratch built boats as well as a class for "on the water" sailing. Don't forget, the event starts early at 10am, to allow the paddle boats back on the water for mid day.
