A new event for this year is the Spithead Review which is to be held on the evening of 13th August at Silverdale. The club has invited the new Lieutenant Governor, Sir Paul Haddacks, to inspect the fleet on the lake. The event is predominantly aimed at naval vessels (Sir Paul is ex Royal Navy), but other vessels are welcome attend and we will be encouraging members to turn up to put on a good show. More details of this event will appear in a newsletter nearer the time.

Don't forget that club sailing nights are Thursday evenings and Sunday afternoons (early season) or evenings (summer season) after the motor boats have finished at Onchan Park. There is some doubt as to whether the paddle boats will be out at Silverdale this year, so there may be opportunities to hold club Sailing at Silverdale during the evenings as well.

Forthcoming Events

Two events have already happened this year (New Year Sail at Silverdale & the RNLI Commemorative service Display). The next couple of events which are on the calendar are as follows:-

Sunday 9th April - Scale Steering Competition at Onchan Park.

This is the traditional opening event of the summer sailing season and is open to all scale models. The object is to sail your boat around a course marked with buoys on the lake. Points are lost for touching or missing a section and the winner is the skipper with the lowest score after two rounds. The alternative day for this event if we have poor weather is 23rd April.

Sunday 7th May - Scale Competition at Silverdale.

There are actually two competitions in one event at Silverdale. Firstly a static scale competition held at the side of the pool and split into 3 classes for Scratch built, Semi Scratch and Kit built models. Secondly the action turns to the water where we judge the best boat actually sailing 'On the Water'. The club normally invites a guest judge to score the models for this event - make sure that you set your alarm clock as this event is in the morning starting at 10:00am. The poor weather alternative date is 14th May.

Members Subscriptions

New Year Sail at Silverdale

This years new year sail in was held on the 2nd January at Silverdale in what can only be described as perfect conditions for January - very still, a little cold but definitely warmer than last year! There was a good turn out of members with some new vessels taking to the water as well as the regular favourites (see photograph opposite).

The level of the lake was slightly down on normal, but with the use of lifting straps everybody managed to launch and recover their boats without too much difficulty. There must have been a dozen or more boats on the water at one stage, which attracted numerous spectators at various times throughout the afternoon.



It was nice to see one or two Christmas presents on the water as well, particularly the small lifeboats which are sold by the RNLI. Its just a shame that they were suffering from radio interference during the afternoon. With the very small receivers & servos which are available today, it probably wouldn't take too much work to fit a proper radio control to these boats.

One interesting (non floating) model on display was Bill Callow's new radio control lorry, complete with lights & sound effects. Bill just need to build a model boat the right size to tow around on the trailer to complete the outfit. John Williams also showed one or two members his collection of steam engines which he is currently working on.

This turned out to be an enjoyable afternoon and an excellent start to the 2006 season. Lets hope that the mild weather continues into the spring sailing season.
